

Participation and Inclusion Policy



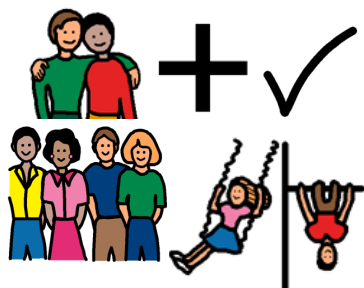
Our Policy is:



We encourage and support you to participate in your community life in the way you choose.



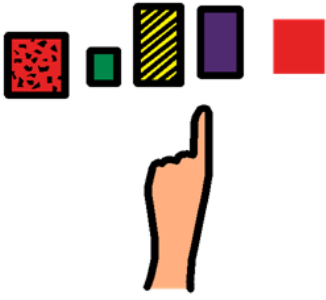
Everyone has the same rights to meaningful inclusion in the community. This includes the areas of work, leisure, learning and relationships.



We promote the benefits of participation and inclusion to you and the community.



We model respectful and inclusive behaviour.



You have the right to be a decision maker about how and who you will connect with in your community and we respect your choices and plans.



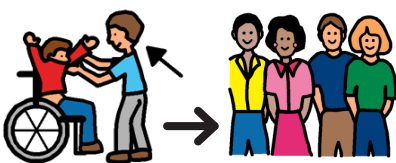
We support inclusion of people from Aboriginal background and different cultural and language backgrounds by forming good relationships with local Aboriginal and cultural organisations.



We support you and your community to find ways to increase inclusion and meaningful participation, including for people with a disability exiting the criminal justice system.



People exiting the criminal justice system have a right to be supported to develop interests and activities in the community.



Carers have a right to participate in their chosen communities in a way that meets their own interests and needs beyond their caring role.
